SCHOOL CONNECTED ORGANIZATIONS

The Board of Education of the Mainland Regional High School District appreciates parents/guardians and other concerned citizens' efforts and shall permit them to form co-curricular booster clubs and shall set the criteria for recognition.

Each group shall submit for board approval a constitution and bylaws that consist of, but is not limited to:

- A. Purpose and objectives;
- B. Membership criteria;
- C. Dues and assessments;
- D. Administration and leadership;
- E. Meeting dates;
- F. Parliamentary procedures;
- G. Dissolution procedures;
- H. Officers and their duties.

Each group shall be incorporated under the State laws as a non-profit organization and shall submit to the board an audit of the previous year and an annual budget to indicate anticipated expenditures and methods to secure the necessary income to cover such expenditures.

Each group's president and vice-president shall be available to attend meetings called by the board of education or by the superintendent or his/her designee. They shall act as liaison between the group and the board of education.

The administration shall comply with board and administrative directives, act to preclude conflicts between individual groups and provide a means to serve each group's common goals.
