SECURITY AT ATHLETIC/CO-CURRICULAR/SCHOOL SPONSORED EVENTS

The Mainland Regional High School Board of Education strives to maintain a safe and secure environment for all students, staff, and visitors by promoting school buildings and grounds that are free from illegal substances and contraband.

Profanity or the use of offensive language or gestures, is prohibited at all times. Visitors cursing or using offensive language or gestures may be ejected from the school facility. Sportsmanship and appropriate behavior is expected at all times.

Prohibited Items Include but not limited to:

-) Alcohol
-) Controlled Substances
-) Tobacco Products (defined to include, but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, blunts, bidis, pipes, chewing tobacco and all other forms of smokeless tobacco, rolling papers any other items that contain or reasonably resemble tobacco or tobacco products, excluding quit products.)
-) Electronic smoking devices (an electronic device that can be used to deliver nicotine or other substances to the person inhaling from the device, including but not limited to, an electronic cigarette, cigar, cigarillo, or pipe.)
-) Bottles/Cans
-) Coolers
-) Outside Food and Beverage
-) Laser pointers
-) Fireworks
-) Air horns, cowbells or noisemakers of any type
-) Weapons of any kind
-) Any sharp or pointed objects subject to being utilized as a weapon
-) Any heavy or blunt objects subject to being utilized as a weapon
-) Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS a.k.a. Drones)
-) No ball playing

The Mainland Regional High School Board of Education reserves the right to enact the following:

1.	All students and visitors are subject to searches by Mainland Regional Security Staff including but not limited to pat downs, metal detecting devices (wands) and visual searches.
2.	All students and visitors are encouraged to leave all bags at home or in their vehicles. All bags may be subject to a search by Mainland Regional Security Staff.
3.	Any student or visitor refusing search of any kind (personal or bag) will be refused entry.
