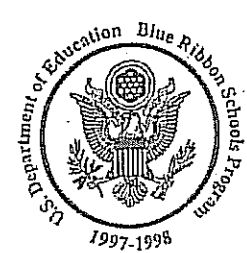

Midterm Examinations & Parent-Teacher Conferences

Dear Parents:

Mainland Regional High School will be conducting **Midterm Examinations** beginning Friday, January 20th through Wednesday, January 25th.

Examination Day/Date	8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.	10:15 a.m. – 12:15 p.m.

Monday, January 23 rd	Period 2	Period 7
Tuesday, January 24 th	Period 3	Period 8
Wednesday, January 25 th	Period 4	Period 9

A student only needs to be present at school during his/her exam periods. An *absence* from an assigned examination will result in the student receiving a “1” for the Midterm Examination, unless documentation or good cause exists, as deemed by the Principal, to permit the make-up of a missed exam. Students will not be permitted to be late to an exam and will not be excused from an exam early. If a student does not have an exam, he/she is excused from school for that exam period. A student is not required to attend any examination period for a study hall. Lunches will not be served during exam days. If school is cancelled due to inclement weather during the exam week, we will continue the exam schedule on the first day back.

Bus transportation will be provided for eligible students on the exam days. Buses will pick students up at the regular morning time and leave school immediately after the 2nd exam at 12:15 p.m. Students that are in attendance at the high school during examination periods, but do not have an exam, are expected to study quietly in the library. Students are not permitted in the hallways during examination periods.

Parent-Teacher conferences will be held on Monday, January 30th. Teachers will be available for conferences from 12:00 p.m. – 1:30 p.m. and from 5:15 p.m. – 6:45 p.m. No appointments are necessary during these times.
