This letter is to inform you about the Advanced Placement Exam, which will take place Monday, May 2, 2011 through Friday, May 13, 2011. On the back of this page is a copy of the exam schedule with the locations and times listed.

We will be utilizing **THREE** different testing locations. Some tests will be take place at Mainland. We will also be holding tests at Linwood Community Church located at 1838 Shore Road in Linwood. The entrance is located in the rear of the building. The majority of our testing will take place at Our Lady of Sorrows Church Social Hall. It is located on the corner of Poplar Avenue and Wabash Avenue in Linwood. Please make sure your child is aware of where he/she needs to report for his/her exam.

Most of the exams have many participants, which will require time for check in, distribution of materials, etc. Please make sure your child arrives at least **15 minutes prior to the start time** of the exam. I am sure you are aware of how important this program is to your student's academic standing. Your commitment is essential. Kindly make sure your child is on time for the exam.

**You SHOULD bring the following items to the exam room:**

- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for all multiple-choice answer sheets
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams
- A watch (in case your exam room does not have a clock that you can see easily)
- A calculator with extra batteries and has the necessary capabilities if you are taking an AP Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics Exam. (Visit [www.collegeboard.com/apstudents](http://www.collegeboard.com/apstudents) to learn more about the calculator policy for each of these exams, and for a list of authorized calculators.)
- A ruler or straightedge if you are taking an AP Physics Exam

**You SHOULD NOT bring the following to the exam room:**

- Cell phones, PDAs, MP3 players, e-mail/messaging devices, and any other electronic or communication devices
- Computers or calculators (except as noted above)
- Books, compasses, colored pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes
- Rulers and straightedges (except as noted above)
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets)
- Watches that beep or have an alarm
- Clothing with subject-related information

***You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and Mainland Regional High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam grade.***
