The Aquatic Commission asked if the Mariner team would be accepting swimmers from other towns other than the sending districts. Mr. Richmond responded that if the enrollment spots were not reached with swimmers from Linwood, Northfield and Somers Point, the Organization would open enrollment to swimmers that resided out of the MRHS District.

Discussion followed regarding the change to the original proposal of the Mainland Mariners. Discussion followed regarding allowing swimmers outside the district to participate. Mr. Richmond noted that the team has expanded to other districts by using the St. Augustine pool facility.

The Commission agreed to approve the request and allow swimmers that reside outside the MRHS district only if interested swimmers from Linwood, Northfield and Somers Point are not excluded from participating on the team.

Mr. Wiesel - Linwood

Spoke on behalf of the Mainland Mariner program and offered suggestions to try to incorporate out of district swimmers.

Mr. Wiesel also inquired about the Tuesday/Thursday program that is being supervised by one of the MRHS swim coaches. The program was approved on the basis that some of the MRHS swimmers wanted to continue to practice during the last weeks of August. Mr. Wiesel stated that some residents left the pool due to the program utilizing three lanes.

Discussion followed regarding the program. MRHS Administration will review the program.

Mr. Wiesel also requested better communication regarding the pool schedule to the public. He noted several times that

the posted calendar changed throughout every month.

Ms. Walls suggested a mass email announcement to the community members to announce any changes.
