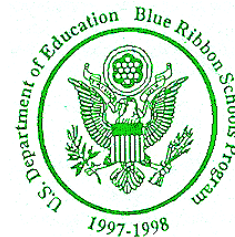

2018 GRADUATION SPEAKERS SELECTION PROCESS

Mainland Regional High School has moved beyond Class Rank and changed the way in which graduation speakers are chosen. We are excited to invite all seniors interested in speaking at graduation to submit a speech to be considered for inclusion in the 2018 Commencement Exercise.

Requirements:

- Speeches should be approximately 3-5 minutes in length
- Speeches should be original and carefully proofread, typed and submitted electronically or printed
- Speeches should be inspired by one of the topics/quotes below (the quote does not have to be included in your speech, but is provided to offer inspiration)

1. Do Not Let Others Define Who You Are

Submission Deadline:

A typed hard copy of your proposed graduation speech must be submitted by 3:00 PM on Friday, **May 18, 2018** to the Principal's Office.

Eligibility:

All students from the Class of 2018 are invited to submit a graduation speech for consideration by the selection committee.

Selection Process:

A committee will be formed to select **two speeches** from the pool of submissions for inclusion in the Graduation Ceremony. Students will be notified of the decision by June 8th and will receive support in preparing their speech for presentation during the graduation ceremony. This will include extra time outside of graduation practices.
