SELECTION PROCESS

Faculty members from Mainland are invited to nominate up to 2 colleagues for this award. Non-tenured teachers are not eligible for this award. Entries must be received by Friday, January 6, 2012, at 2:30 PM. The criteria that you are asked to consider reflects the NJ State Teacher of the Year Program. A selection committee composed of teachers, school administrators, parents, and other citizens will review the nominations and determine a recipient during the week of January 17th.

Teachers nominated should be leaders that reflect the following:

- Poses knowledge of the most current education topics;
- Poses knowledge of the most current teaching and learning strategies;
- Have impacted student achievement and professional learning at the school level;
- Demonstrate the ability to inspire the love of learning in students of all backgrounds and abilities;
- Have long-range potential for leadership opportunities.

Teachers nominated must have received exemplary local district evaluation reports and have acceptable personnel records devoid of recent sanctions or deficiencies.
