Tutorial Services has been in business for the past four years. This year alone we have already seen a tremendous improvement from pre-assessment to past assessment results. Last year in Georgia 48% of our students who had failed the state test the previous year had passed this year. During the year of 2008-2009 our students begun the program with an average Language Arts pretest score of 58.3% and the average of the post test score is 65.3%. This would be an average increase of 7%. Mathematics began the year with an average test score of 60.6% and has ended with an average of 72.2%. This would be an 11.6% increase from pretest to post test score
